EMBLEM

On a disc Azure, on an irregular pentagon shield Argent, a dragon segreant Gules armed Argent above and between a demi-chaplet of laurel Or, joined by a bezant, all within a diminished border Sable. Attached above the disc, a Yellow scroll edged with a narrow Black border and inscribed "100TH COMPTROLLER SQ" in Black letters. Attached below the disc, a Yellow scroll edged with a narrow Black border and inscribed "PEOPLE-MONEY-AIRPOWER" in Black letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The dragon is a most valiant defender. The white diamond shape represents treasure significant of the funds entrusted to the unit. The laurel garland serves as a symbol of peace and excellence. (Approved, 6 May 1999)
