Under BRAC 2005, the Air Guard wing is adding the new facility for its state-of-the-art center as well as offices, conference space, and training areas. The wing's 103rd Air and Space Operations Group will manage the AOC, which is expected to commence initial operations next spring. "As we literally build this new capability from the ground up, I see a bright future ahead of us," said Col. Peter DePatie, 103rd AOG boss.
