In May, 1973 a reorganization within the 103<sup>rd</sup> Tactical Fighter Group result in the elimination of the Supply Sq. and the activation of two new flights. The reasons for the change was to bring ANG unit structure in line with Air Force's wartime mobility needs. The new flights are the 103<sup>rd</sup> Mobility Flight made up of three officers and 60 enlisted men and the 103<sup>rd</sup> Weapons System Security Flight with one officer and 36 enlisted men, all are security policemen. Most of the personnel and functions of the Supply Sq. will go into the Combat Support Sq. That Squadron's strength now goes from 192 men to an authorized strength of some 216 people.
