The 108 TAC Clinic's scheduled overseas annual training in Sep 90 was rescheduled by the National Guard Bureau. Approximately 45 personnel deployed to Shaw AFB, S.C. to backfill for active duty personnel deployed to Southwest Asia. The clinic's deployment lasted two weeks. A flight medical technician remained at Shaw for six months.
