#### **OPERATIONS**

Constituted in the National Guard in 1921 as Balloon Company No. 111, assigned to the 13th Balloon Group (IV Corps), and allotted to the state of Mississippi. Jackson, MS, designated as headquarters on organization, but the unit was never organized at that location. Redesignated

as the 111th Balloon Company on 25 January 1923 and assigned to the 34th Balloon Group (IV Corps). Placed on the deferred list on 2 July 1923, unit requirement transferred to the Organized Reserve as a Deferred National Guard unit, and replaced by the 461st Balloon Company. Withdrawn from allotment to the National Guard on 17 September 1927 and demobilized.
