OPERATIONS

During the period 9-23 June 1979, the Communications Flight performed annual training at Lowry AFB, Colorado.

The 118 Communications Flight pulled their Annual Training at Eglin Air Force Base FL from 18 April to 1 May 1981.

From 26 February through 12 March 1983, the 118 Communications Flight performed annual field training at George Air Force Base CA. Twenty individuals were deployed and assigned to the Collocated Operating Base (COB) Team. A COB is an Active Allied Airfield which supports United States Air Force aircraft during contingencies that require us to deploy to Europe. The 118 Communications Flight trained to prepositioning communications vans to be linked with the current AUTODIN system to provide long and short hand communications.

From 16-30 June 1984, the 118 Communications Flight performed annual active duty training at Mildenhall RAF. England.

During September 1984, 118 Communications Flight performed the semi-annual COMSEC Inspection.
