## **OPERATIONS**

During the last 10 years, the 132<sup>nd</sup> TAC Hospital has increased authorized manning by 33 personnel. We now have 22 officers and 50 enlisted personnel authorized.

Hospital personnel have supported Wing deployments, including overseas to England, Japan, and Panama. Personnel were called to active duty to Offutt AFB in support of Desert Shield/Storm in February 91. Many volunteered to support TAC missions at Langley and Shaw Air Force Bases. Personnel were integrated with our Active Duty counterparts, and performed a magnificent job with everyone receiving "a big pat on the pack". Our Environmental Health Officer completed a critical manning tour at Edwards AFB, CA to help in food service inspection, sanitation, and food handler training.

For the first time in the history of this unit, we've had 2 Senior Flight Surgeons (SFS); Lt Col Raymond Webster, Chief of Aeromedical Services, and our Commander, Col Nirmalendu K. Pandeya. Col Pandeya was appointed as the military consultant in plastic surgery to the AF Surgeon General starting in 1990.
