OPERATIONS

Prior to the 1950 reorganization of the Minnesota Air National Guard as a Wing, the Group

operated under tactical control of the 86th Fighter Wing, Denver. Within the 133d Wing organization were formed four groups at Holman Field: 133d Fighter Group, commanded by Lt. Col. John R. Dolny; 133d Maintenance and Supply Group, commanded by Maj. Arthur Petter; 133d Air Base Group, commanded by Col. Ernest Berg, and 133d Medical Group, commanded by Maj. Mentor Christenson. Field training for the St. Paul based units prior to the Korean War was held at Camp Ripley and Volk Field.

133d Medical Group: Federalized ANG on 2 March 1951 at Holman Field, MN, and assigned to 133d Fighter-Interceptor Wing; moved to Minneapolis-St. Paul International Airport, MN, on 28 June 1951; inactivated on 6 February 1952.
