EMBLEM

On a disc per fess nebuly Azure and Gules, issuant there from to chief a demi-bear Tenné, eye and nose garnished Sable, grasping in its upraised dexter paw a wrench bendwise sinister Argent, in base a horseshoe heel to base Or, nail holes Sable, winged as a vol White, all within a diminished bordure Yellow. Attached above the disc, a White scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "139TH MAINTENANCE SQ" in Blue letters. Attached below the disc, a White scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "UBIQUE IN BELLUM ET PACIS" in Blue letters.

EMBLEM SIGNIFICANCE

Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The nebuly division reflects the union and thus strength of the three support squadrons that make up the 139th Maintenance complex. The Squadron's home state of Missouri is denoted by a bear, a state symbol signifying the unit's bravery, endurance and strength. The bear grasps a wrench indicating the unit's maintenance function. The winged horseshoe stands for good luck in all sorties for all operational units who have the best available equipment maintenance by the Squadron.
