OPERATIONS

On the 26th of January 1968 all elements of the Nevada Air National Guard except the State Headquarters in Carson City, were called to active duty with the United States Air Force. The call-up was ordered by President Lyndon B. Johnson as he responded to the crisis created by the North Korean capture of the USS Pueblo. The recall differed from the 19-51 tour as there was no alert or get-ready" period involved.

The 152d Combat Support Squadron was reduced in assigned strength to thirty airmen and relocated to Suwon.

By the end of August 1968 all units and personnel of the Nevada Air National Guard had been reassigned and relocated. This was the largest reassignment action in the history of recalled Air National Guard units.

In Dec 1968, it was announced that the recalled units and their assigned personnel would be demobilized effective 9 June 1969.
