Operations Noble Eagle and Enduring Freedom (October 2001-March 2003) The events of September 11, 2001, led to the mobilization of numerous military units around the world, including two Nevada Air National Guard units. The Air Guard's 152nd Intelligence Squadron and 152nd Security Forces Squadron each mobilized and deployed within a matter of weeks after the tragic events of Sept. 11

The 152nd Security Forces Squadron was mobilized Oct. 16, 2001. Squads deployed separately to perform force protection, law enforcement and installation security missions in Afghanistan, Qatar, Tajikistan and throughout the continental United States. The squadron was retained in September 2002 for another year of activation.

2009 The 152nd Forces Support Squadron has about 10 airmen in Kyrgyzstan. These personnel support Operation Enduring Freedom by operating the dining, lodging, fitness and recreation facilities at military sites in the country.
