OPERATIONS

The mission of the 154th Logistics Group is to provide the National Command Authority with equipped units, fully trained and qualified personnel, available for active duty with the Air Force in time of war, national emergency, or such other times as the interests of the United States may require. Collectively, the organization is capable of employing trained personnel dedicated to maintain aircraft for air defense, air superiority, air refueling and theater airlift forces around the globe with minimum notification. The 154th Logistics Group possesses trained and qualified aircraft maintenance and supply personnel capable of supporting the integrated air defense, fighter, tanker and transport assets of the 154th Wing.

The 154th Logistics Group was implemented October 1, 1994, as part of the Air National Guard's reorganization program, bringing the group structure in agreement with active duty Air Force units. The unit was officially dedicated February 15, 1995, with an authorized strength of 905 personnel.
