## EMBLEM

On a disc Azure, a globe Vert arraswise from the north pole axis bendwise gridlined Sable charged with a silhouette of a tanker aircraft of the like overall in saltire a screwdriver in bend tip to base debruised by a double end wrench Or garnished of the second, all within a diminished border per border Yellow within Black. Attached above the disc, a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and Black border and inscribed "155 MXS" in Yellow letters. Attached below the disc a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and Black border and inscribed "SUPPORTING FLIGHT" in Yellow letters. Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The globe denotes the unit's worldwide mission. The screwdriver and wrench symbolize the maintenance functions

performed by the Squadron. The silhouette flight symbol suggests the specialized type of aircraft serviced by the unit.
