Since 1992, the tempo of the 165th Operations Group has soared. In 1993 the unit supported many major deployments to include Operation DESERT CALM, flying airlift support in Saudi Arabia, and Operation PROVIDE PROMISE, flying humanitarian airlift into Bosnia-Herzegovina. In 1994 the unit supported deployments to Operation SUPPORT HOPE, flying humanitarian airlift to Rwanda, and Operation SUPPORT DEMOCRACY, flying airlift missions into Haiti.
