EMBLEM

On a disc Gules, issuant from a terrestrial demi-globe Azure, landmasses Vert, emitting from the Eastern United States landmass and orbiting the globe bendwise, a lightning bolt terminating in

dexter in a stylized flight symbol Or, supported by the lightning bolt a unicorn passant Argent, eyed Sable, all within a narrow border Black. Attached above the disc, a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Black border and inscribed "MOUNTAINEER PRIDE WORLDWIDE" in Black letters. Attached below the disc, a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Black border and inscribed "167TH LOGISTICS READINESS SQ" in Black letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The globe symbolizes the worldwide scope of the unit. The lightning bolt, with flight symbol, represents the seamless collaboration of each branch of the unit for sustained mission accomplishment across the globe. The unicorn denotes the parent wing, the 167th Airlift Wing, and its origins from the 369th Fighter Squadron during World War II.
