EMBLEM

On a disc Azure, a stylized male demi-cardinal Proper in fighting attitude bearing a quiver over his sinister shoulder Sable, secured by a strap bendwise sinister across his breast and holding six arrows of the like fletched Or; carried under his dexter wing, two lightning bolts parallel in

bend Yellow and under his sinister wing a wrench, jaws upward Argent, all within a narrow border Black. Attached above the disc, a Gray scroll edged with a narrow Black border and inscribed "192D MAINT SQ" in Black letters. Attached below the disc, a Gray scroll edged with a narrow Black border and inscribed "FIXIN' TO FIGHT" in Black letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The cardinal symbolizes the Commonwealth of Virginia. The wrench represents the maintenance mission of the unit. The lightning bolts mirror electricity and the energy required to perform the unit mission. The arrows signify weaponry and the Squadron's dedication to maintaining munitions.
