### **MISSION**

The Combat Support Squadron provides members of the 193rd Special Operations Group as well as eight geographically separated units at Fort Indiantown Gap and State College with personnel records maintenance and support, training services, and a complete audio-visual resource center. Food Service for the 193rd SOG is also managed by the 193rd Combat Support Squadron. Other unit support services provided by the 193rd CSS are: Judge Advocate, Chaplain, Base Administration, Publishing/Documentation, Consolidated Base Personnel Office, Recruiting, Social Actions, Visual Information Services, Law Enforcement, Base Housing and Food Services, Small Arms Training, and Disaster Preparedness. Total membership in the 193rd Combat Support Squadron is 97 enlisted members and twelve officers.

The Squadron occupies most of Building 26, known as Headquarters, but in 1988 will occupy a brand-new Operations and Training Building to be built in the Air National Guard Complex at Harrisburg International Airport.

The 193rd Motor Pool, formerly assigned to the 193rd Combat Support Squadron was reassigned to the 193rd Resource Management Squadron in mid 1982.
