The 200th Weather Squadron has the mission of developing the capability to assist its parent weather wing in the mobilization and deployment of 39 Air National Guard weather flights located throughout the United States. During peacetime the 200th provides guidance and direction to the 39 flights on technical, tactical and administrative training matters. It provides any assistance to help them achieve operational readiness. Much of this advice is provided during staff assistance visits to the weather flights, which, when mobilized, are tasked to provide weather support to US Army operations.

The 200th Weather Flight had been based at Langley AFB in Hampton, Virginia since 1965, was reorganized in 1989. It is now based in Sandston and has the primary mission of providing

weather support to units of the 29th Division, Virginia Army National Guard.
