## **OPERATIONS**

Constituted in the Organized Reserve on 29 July 1921 as the 312th Balloon Company, assigned to the 43rd Balloon Group (redesignated as the 543rd Balloon Group on 20 February 1924), and allotted to the Third Corps Area. Initiated in September 1922 at Uniontown, PA. Inactivated on 3 December 1926 at Uniontown by relief of personnel. Reorganized by June 1932 at the Pittsburgh Airport, Pittsburgh, PA. Redesignated as the 312th Balloon Squadron on 1 October 1933. Inactivated by June 1935 at Pittsburgh by relief of personnel. Status: Disbanded on 31 May 1942.
