OPERATIONS

During 1955, the concept of Wing Specialized Maintenance was initiated on a six month trial basis and all responsibility for aircraft maintenance was deleted from the mission of the group and assigned to the Wing Director of Material.

Shortly after this change, in May, 1955, the activities of the group were integrated with those of the 317th Air Base Group. This consolidation remained in effect until September, 1955, when action was taken to re-man Headquarters, 317th Maintenance and Supply Group and establish operational control.

Significantly, the concept of specialized maintenance was continued with this reorganization, and once again established the Maintenance and Supply Group as the agency responsible for all aircraft maintenance and Base Supply activities.
