Initiated in May 1922 with headquarters at Danville, IN. Relocated on 15 April 1925 to Louisville, KY. Inactivated by March 1930 at Louisville by relief of personnel. Reorganized and redesignated as Headquarters and Headquarters Squadron, 318th Attack Group on 1 October 1933. Lima, OH, designated 21 December 1933 as headquarters on reorganization, but the unit was never organized at that location.
