#### **EMBLEM**

Sable, a chevron enhanced Azure, overall an eagle volant Gold Brown shaded Buff grasping in its dexter talons a lightning flash bendwise and in its sinister talons a lightning flash Or; all within a diminished bordure of the last. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Blue and yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The chevron symbolizes the support provided by the unit to its parent organization. It also reflects the unique role the squadron has as a bridge between the military and civilian communities. The eagle grasping the lightning flashes stands for America's air power. (Approved, 25 Jun 1996)
