Constituted in the Organized Reserve on 15 October 1921, assigned to the 8th Attack Wing (Third Army), and allotted to the Ninth Corps Area. Initiated in May 1922 with headquarters at San Diego, CA. Relieved from the Third Army 13 June 1924 and assigned to the General Headquarters Reserve. Inactivated 20 October 1929 at San Diego by relief of personnel. Reorganized 28 January 1930 with headquarters at Los Angeles, CA. Withdrawn from the Ninth Corps Area 1 October 1933 and demobilized.
