

Azure, seven mascles conjoined three, three, and one, or on a chief nebule of the last three dexter hands spaume gules. SIGNIFICANCE: The ultramarine blue and golden orange are the colors of the Air Forces. The service functions of the group are attractively symbolized by the three sturdy right hands of the personnel ready for any assignment. The nebule partition of the shield is the heraldic representation of clouds. The conjoined mascles like all other square figures denotes honesty and probably was the root of the expression "square dealings." The numerical designated is indicated by the arrangement of the mascles, three, three, and one.
