Initiated in September 1924 with headquarters at Schoen Field, Fort Benjamin Harrison, IN. Designated mobilization training station was Schoen Field. Reorganized and redesignated as Headquarters and Headquarters Squadron, 333rd Observation Group on 1 October 1933. Inactivated by March 1930 at Schoen Field by relief of personnel. Typically conducted Inactive Training Period meetings at Schoen Field. Location 7 December 1941—Inactive. Disbanded 31 May 1942.
