Aerial transportation in CBI, 14 Jun 1944-29 Sep 194.5; airlift of Chinese troops to eastern China for disarmament operations, Oct-Nov 1945.

Squadron's mission carry ground troops and auxiliary combat equipment to effective locations in a combat zone, maintain combat reinforcements, supply and resupply units in the combat zone and evacuate casualties and other personnel from such zones. Seeing that these new units were to be carrying cargo into the heart of the battle, the new units were called Combat Cargo.
