366th Balloon Company Constituted in the Organized Reserve on 29 July 1921 as the 366th Balloon Company, assigned to the 65th Balloon Group (redesignated as the 565th Balloon Group on 20 February 1924), and allotted to the Sixth Corps Area. Initiated in 1922 at Belleville, IL. Inactivated by June 1929 at Belleville by relief of personnel. Redesignated as the 366th Balloon Squadron on 1 October 1933. Reorganized about January 1938 at Detroit, MI. Conducted annual summer training at Scott Field, IL, 1922-40. Status: Disbanded on 31 May 1942.
