The 366 CES is an almost 400-person squadron directly supporting F-15E operations of the 366 Fighter Wing by improving, maintaining and operating more than 1,300 housing units and more than 1,400 facilities, including all infrastructure. Provides fire protection, disaster preparedness, explosive ordnance disposal, environmental protection and maintains readiness for a more than 200-person mobility commitment. The squadron manages a \$200 million design and construction program.






