Constituted in the Organized Reserve on 29 July 1921 as the 373rd Balloon Company, assigned to the 67th Balloon Group (redesignated as the 567th Balloon Group on 20 February 1924), and allotted to the Eighth Corps Area. Galveston, TX, designated as headquarters on organization,

but the unit was never organized at that location. Withdrawn from the Eighth Corps Area on 31 March 1924 and allotted to the Ninth Corps Area. Initiated in November 1925 at Portland, OR. Conducted annual summer training at Ross Field, CA. Demobilized on 1 October 1933.
