EMBLEM

375th Logistics Readiness Squadron emblem: On a disc Vert, two swords in saltire points to chief blades Silver Gray, guards and pommels Or, handled Sable, surmounted throughout by a stylized falcon displayed of the last, eyed of the third, all within a narrow border Yellow. Attached above the disc, a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "ANYTIME AND ANYWHERE" in Yellow letters. Attached below the disc, a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow

border and inscribed "375TH LOGISTICS READINESS SQ" in Yellow letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The swords symbolize power; the falcon signifies logistics.
