The 388 MOS develops, plans, and implements programs for all wartime tasks, coordinates direct support for flight line operations and serves as the wing liaison with Air Force Material Command host on support issues.

The unit directs all wing aircraft maintenance training, environment management, transportation and civil engineering programs.

The squadron has approximately 200 support personnel assigned to five flights and a vehicle maintenance element which provides support for the 388 Maintenance Group staff, Quality Assurance and Weapons Load Training.




