EMBLEM



On a disc per reversed chevron nebuly blue and white, a chevron abased divided per nebuly gold and green bearing on the gold portion within a white annulet a green cobra's head and neck couped wearing a white crown and in chief two lightning flashes, one red and one gold, terminating in white flight symbols, braced and infilling a white annulet; all within a narrow gold border. Below the emblem a blue scroll edged gold. SIGNIFICANCE: The emblem is symbolic of the squadron. Against the background of blue with white clouds which depicts the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations, the gold and green chevron symbolizes the Squadron's strength in support of its parent wing and its excellence in performance. The King Cobra denotes the squadron's service in Thailand. The lightning flashes represent the striking power of the weapons maintained by the squadron. The lightning interlaced, passing through the ring, and terminating in flight symbols allude to the capability of the squadron's parent wing to successfully penetrate enemy defenses and deliver the weapons. The emblem p bears the national colors and the Air Force colors of gold and ultramarine blue.
