Initiated in November 1921 at Pittsfield, MA. Redesignated as the 391st Observation Squadron on 25 January 1923. Relieved from assignment to the 301st Observation Group (Fourth Army) on 31 March 1924 and assigned to the 307th Observation Group (Fourth Army). Withdrawn from the First Corps Area on 5 June 1936 and allotted to the Second Corps Area. Elizabeth, NJ, designated as headquarters on organization, but the unit was never organized at that location. Status: Disbanded on 31 May 1942.
