Initiated in 1922 at Flint, MI. Redesignated as the 398th Balloon Service Company on 25 January 19 23. Relocated on 2 June 1925 to Kalamazoo, MI. Inactivated by June 1929 at Kalamazoo by relief of personnel. Reorganized by June 1932 at Kalamazoo. Redesignated as the 398th Service Squadron, Balloon Group on 1 October 1933. Conducted annual summer training at Scott Field, IL, 1922-40. Status: Disbanded on 31 May 1942.
