Squadron mission was to provide highly trained worldwide deployable force packages capable of accomplishing Aircraft Battle Damage Repair augmentation, field-level maintenance on assigned aircraft, and Rapid Area Distribution Support for contingency and/or combat supply and packaging operations. Personnel mobilize and deploy to support various war and contingency plans in hostile environments.

Aircraft damaged while involved in missions in hostile areas may not have time or be capable to return home for repairs. When time is of the essence, repairs are made at the deployed sites. The 433d Combat Logistics Support Squadron trained reservists for such tasks. The unit provided worldwide deployable 14 member teams who performed aircraft battle damage repairs, as well as augmented supply and surface freight management operations.
