EMBLEM

An intertwined purple circle and triangle is centered on an ultramarine azure disc. A sable silhouette or a bald eagle is positioned inside the triangle at the fess point. The disk is bordered with or. An ultramarine azure scroll is attached below the disc. The scroll, which is blank is bordered also with or. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are used in the design. Blue represents the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow signifies the sun and the excellence required of Air Force Personnel. The intertwined purple circle and triangle is the international symbol of dentistry and alludes to the squadron's primary mission. The silhouette of the bald eagle refers to our national pride and support of the 436th Airlift Wing.
