#### **OPERATIONS**

Since the end of the Vietnam War, the 437th Transportation Squadron has been awarded six subsequent Air Force Outstanding Unit Awards for its role in support of the Invasion of Grenada (Operation URGENT FURY), the invasion of Panama (Operation JUST CAUSE), the defense of Saudi Arabia (Operation DESERT SHIELD), and the liberation of Kuwait (Operation DESERT STORM). Additionally, the squadron played an important role in humanitarian missions, including the recovery efforts after Hurricane Hugo in 1989, Hurricane Andrew in 1992, the Rwandan relief effort, and more recently, the search and recovery operations in Oklahoma City, OK. The squadron also played a key role and the invasion of Haiti (Operation UPHOLD DEMOCRACY). The unit was also awarded the Best Vehicle Operations Flight in AMC Award in 1993. On 1 October 1991, the 437th Transportation Squadron was reorganized under the 437th Logistics Group.
