## **EMBLEM**

On a disc Azure a pair of wings inverted Argent charged with a cross Gules overall for deltas, one in chief, one in dexter, one in base, one in sinister all Sable fimbriated Or, all within a narrow border Yellow. Attached below the disc, a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "455TH EXP MEDICAL SUPPORT SQ" in Yellow letters. Attached above the disc, a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "WE CAN WE WILL" in

Yellow letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The wings represent the purity of intent of battlefield medical care while the medical cross signifies the blood of life given by combat medics as they place themselves in harm's way. The flight symbols signify the fact that our nation's adversaries surround Airmen from all sides.
