#### **EMBLEM**

On a disc Azure, a bird of prey's talon issuant from sinister chief Argent (Silver Gray), shaded Gris, claws highlighted of the second (White), emitting a lightning bolt bendwise sinister throughout beveled Or and Gules, between two deltas palewise in bend, delta points to chief White, tailed of the fifth, all within a narrow border Yellow. Attached below the disc, a Blue

scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "477TH AIRCRAFT MAINTENANCE SQ" in Yellow letters. **SIGNIFICANCE**: Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The raptorial bird's talon emitting a bolt of lightning speaks to the strength and power of the Squadron's commitment to maintain and fight in combat operations all over the world. The two deltas represent Total Force partners on parallel flight paths in pursuit of a common goal
