EMBLEM



On a disc Azure, an unfurled scroll bendwise Buff, pierced by a quill per pale Argent, tip Or, feathers Gules, encircled by eleven mullets of the third, fimbriated Sable; all within a narrow Yellow border. Attached above the disc, a Black scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "CUNIS AD SEPULCRUM" in Yellow letters. Attached below the disc, a Black scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "482D CONTRACTING FLT" in Yellow letters. SIGNIFICANCE: Ultramarine Blue and Air Force Yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The scroll represents the original vehicle used by contracting professionals to procure resources required by warfighters to accomplish the mission. The quill highlights the unit's effective and efficient process of executing contracts. The white stars signify the combatant commands that reserve contracting personnel support during peacetime, contingency, and disaster relief operations. (Approved, 10 Sep 2021)
