The 1 Communications Squadron provided combat-ready communications and information systems, to include audio-visual and air traffic control systems, for the 1 Fighter Wing and Headquarters Air Combat Command, ensuring readiness for worldwide warfighting missions. It serviced more than 10,000 personnel with unclassified and classified systems support, including more than 30 associate units, and managed a \$4-million annual budget, more than \$100 million dollars in equipment and 500 personnel.
