### **OPERATIONS**

On 20 Jan 1981, flight nurses of the 2 Aeromedical Evacuation Squadron evacuated the fifty-two American hostages released by Iran after 444 days of captivity. The hostages were flown to Wiesbaden USAF Medical Center, Germany, where they received an interim medical evaluation before returning to the United States.

Between 23 Oct and 9 Dec 1983 2 Aeromedical Evacuation Squadron flight nurses and nursing technicians, after the terrorist bombing of the U.S. Marine barracks in Beirut, Lebanon, helped airlift a total of seventy-eight injured Marines to Wiesbaden USAF Hospital and two Army general hospitals in Germany.
