3 Security Police Group emblem: Azure, on a bend celeste fimbriated argent three four-pointed mullets argent fimbriated azure, in chief a polestar argent fimbriated celeste; all within a diminished bordure or. Blue and yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The polestar symbolizes direction and guidance. The blue band signifies the defense and protection mission of the unit. The three stars indicate the unit's numerical designation.
