EMBLEM

The emblem with its background of atmosphere space, is symbolic of its primary mission. The rocket represents research and development of atmosphere and space vehicles. The radar echo indicates a radar scope presentation of a hurt-tease, one of nature's most violent weather phenomena. The balloon and rawinsonde are symbols of the group's responsibility for monitoring the AWS upper air observing program. The emblem bears the Air Force colors of ultramarine blue and golden yellow, and the national colors of red, white, and blue. (Approved, 6 May 1959)
