Redesignated as Headquarters, 14th Bombardment Wing on 8 May 1929. South Bend, IN, designated on 21 December 1933 as headquarters on organization, but the unit was never

organized at that location. Redesignated as Headquarters and Headquarters Squadron, 14th Bombardment Wing on 1 September 1936.
