Constituted in the Organized Reserve on 21 Mar 1924 as Headquarters, 1st Air Brigade (Bombardment) and allotted to the Second Corps Area. Mineola, Long Island, NY, designated as headquarters on organization, but the unit was never organized at that location. Redesignated 28 Apr 1926 as Headquarters, 1st Bombardment Brigade. Withdrawn from the Organized Reserve on 8 May 1929 and allotted to the Regular Army. Concurrently withdrawn from the Second Corps Area and allotted to the Eighth Corps Area. Kelly Field, TX, designated as headquarters

on organization, but the unit was never organized at that location. Designated mobilization training station was the Air Corps Training Center, Kelly Field. Redesignated 18 Jun 1929 as Headquarters, 21st Bombardment Brigade.
