## OPERATIONS

By June 6, 1942, the 25th Air Depot Group had arrived at the base from Brookley Field, AL. Its mission was to maintain and repair aircraft for the entire Antilles region, including transient aircraft.

The 25th Air Depot Group repaired or serviced 1,982 aircraft during the year. This depot, by the close of 1943, employed 6,247 officers, enlisted men, and civilians.

November 16th, the 25th Air Depot Group departed for the U.S. A reduced-size depot operation was taken over by the 55th Service Squadron of the 348th Service Group.1943
