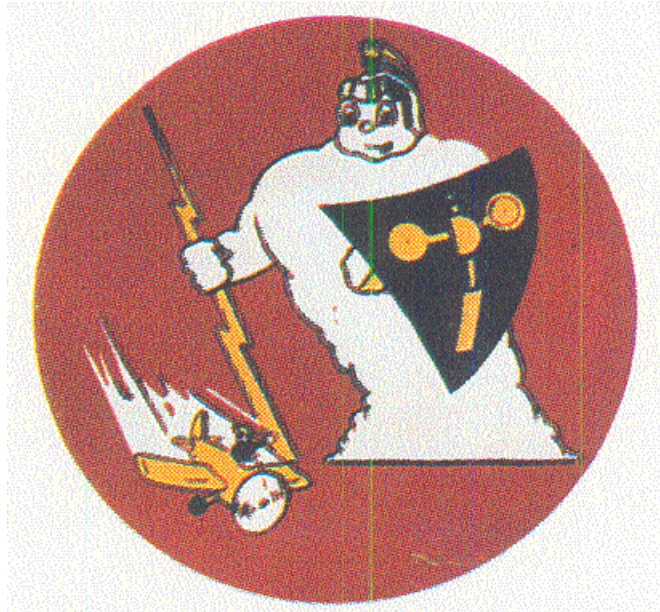


## 25<sup>th</sup> WEATHER SQUADRON



### LINEAGE

Constituted the 25th Weather Squadron on 28 October 1943  
activated four days later  
disbanded on 7 September 1944  
reconstituted the 25th Weather Squadron on 18 May 1948  
activated 1 June 1948.  
inactivated 30 June 1972  
activated 1 January 1975.
