EMBLEM



The HQ Reserve National Security Space Institute provides space education and training to joint forces. The patch is designed to represent: "Charting the future by providing full spectrum space education and training to the joint warfighter." First is the element of three stars, blue, red and grey, representing friendly, enemy and civilian space systems respectively. The second element is a portion of the globe representing the global influence of space and is important for relevance to the third element. The third element is a sextant representing "charting a course" or "providing navigation/direction." As part of the third element are four lightening bolls emitting from the sextant, representing that we are imparting this "direction" towards a particular audience. The audience is joint warfighter, represented by the four destinations of the lightening bolts. Visually, the termination of the four bolts (left to right) is the atmosphere (air), land, sea and space. The top rocker has the motto, "Ultra Terminum Navigans," which is Latin for "Navigating Beyond the Horizon." The conversion from Latin to English is not definitive so there are several ways it can be translated. The meaning is essentially the same.

Col. Bill Havens, supports the newly designated 319th Combat Training Squadron, formerly the
