## **OPERATIONS**

In Nov 55, A C-47 aircraft of the 4050 ABG crashed into the Connecticut River Near Kelpoke Ma.

04 Sep 56-Westover changed from single-wing to two-wing concept. The 57<sup>th</sup> Air Division controlled both the 4050<sup>th</sup> AREFWG and the 99BW. Many of the existing 4050<sup>th</sup> sub-units, such as those under the 4050<sup>th</sup> Air Base Group fell under the 814<sup>th</sup> numerical designation. Units remaining under the 4050<sup>th</sup> AREFWG were the 4050<sup>th</sup> Headquarters Squadron Section (HSS), 26<sup>th</sup> AREFS, 384 AREFS, 4050<sup>th</sup> Field Maintenance Squadron (FMS), 4050<sup>th</sup> Periodic Maintenance Squadron (PMS), and the 4050<sup>th</sup> Armament and Electronics Squadron (A&ES).
